This is a unique physician/midwife collaborative approach to care which includes working alongside excellent and supportive certified nurse midwives that includes 24/7 in house support and a level III NICU. The specialist will practice autonomously and in coordination with Scripps Clinic physicians, Labor and Delivery Midwives, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners within the department of Obstetrics and gynecology to provide quality, safe, compassionate, and effective health care to a diverse patient population.

- Manage emergencies on Labor and Delivery and perform operative vaginal deliveries and C-sections.
- Management of maternal- fetal medicine patients, walk-in patients, and maternal transfer patients.
- Effectively communicate and interact professionally, positively, and constructively with staff, providers, patients, and the general public of varying and diverse backgrounds.
- Participates in Obstetrics and Gynecology program development.
