The candidate will have opportunity to participate in quality improvement and clinical research projects, depending on area of interest.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities of this Level**

- Take patient histories, conduct physical examinations, and record the data in the patient's EMR; EPIC; write progress notes and narrative discharge summaries; prepare patient workups and summaries noting pertinent positive and negative findings. Order and schedule laboratory studies and diagnostic procedures; explain the necessity, preparation, nature and anticipated effects of scheduled diagnostic and therapeutic procedures to the patient.
- Learn bone marrow harvesting and small minor procedures
- Assist with oversight for PBSC collections and infusion management
