APC– Acute Care Surgery/Trauma

Under general supervision of the Acute Care Surgery/Trauma physicians, the Advanced Practice Practitioner (APP) is a member of an interdisciplinary team responsible for delivering direct patient care and providing full clinical support in the management of a diverse population in both the inpatient and outpatient setting. Duties include evaluating and examining patients, rounding, assisting in the operating room, ordering appropriate tests and treatments, documenting medical services, and performing procedures on patients of varying acuity. The APP provides comprehensive services across the hospitalization course including to those patients requiring critical, progressive care, medical-surgical, operative, emergency, and consulting services. In addition to inpatient duties, the APP also participates in the outpatient clinic, providing post hospitalization follow up care.
