The Oncology Nurse Practitioner will work closely with and is supervised by a SCMG medical oncologist specializing in the care of patients with GI cancers, such as colorectal and pancreatic cancer. The position requires a current California NP medical license. Oncology experience, including management of chemotherapy toxicities, is preferred.

Key Responsibilities

- Assess cancer patients independently and in collaboration with the oncologist.
- Manage acute and chronic oncologic and immunotherapy-related conditions.
- Perform routine clinic history and physicals of established patients.
- Order laboratory studies and diagnostic procedures; explain the necessity, preparation, nature and anticipated effects of scheduled diagnostic procedures and treatments to patients.
- Assist supervising physician & care team with triage of established patients.
