

## **SEARCHING FOR A RHEUMATOLOGY PHYSICIAN**

### General Description

The Division of Rheumatology of SCMG is actively looking to hire an additional rheumatologist with a strong commitment to teaching, patient care, and quality improvement. Our division is currently made up of nine rheumatologists each who enjoy and are active in clinical patient care as well as graduate medical education.

Rheumatologists in the division diagnose and treat all rheumatologic autoimmune conditions. We practice at both hospital-based and satellite rheumatology outpatient clinics alongside our multi-specialty group providers making for an efficient, academic, and collegial approach to patient care. We also see rheumatology hospital consultations at two Scripps hospitals in close vicinity to include Scripps Green and Scripps Memorial Hospital, La Jolla.

Our rheumatology division has an ACGME accredited fellowship training program. We train one rheumatology fellow per year and we have aspirations to train two per year in the near future. We are looking for an academic rheumatologist/CE (clinician educator) who has experience in a teaching environment.

### Key Responsibilities

Full-time rheumatologist (FTE1.0) which includes one-half day off per week.

On-call for one week averaging once every 9 weeks which includes both urgent rheumatology outpatient consultations and follow-ups as well staff attending for rheumatology inpatient consultations for two hospitals

Teaching fellows on average of 1-2 half-day session per week in outpatient clinic and occasionally internal medicine residents from the Scripps IM residency programs

Participating in weekly academic rheumatology grand rounds with staff and fellows with a commitment to being the primary presenter 1- 2 times per academic year as well as attending city-wide rheumatology grand rounds twice yearly co-sponsored by both Scripps Clinic and University of California (UCSD) rheumatology fellowship programs

Additional optional compensated teaching opportunities for the fellowship program to include clinical didactics and musculoskeletal ultrasound

### Requirements

- Candidates must be board-certified in rheumatology.
- Candidates must have or be eligible for a California medical license or equivalent certification/permit as determined by the Medical Board of California.
- Rheumatology clinical practice 3 years or more
- Experience in teaching rheumatology fellows
