General Description

Full time Physician Assistant or Nurse Practitioner for outpatient Cardiac Device Clinic as part of a multi-person collaborative team.

Key Responsibilities

Collaborate in the management of patients and interrogation of cardiac devices (ICD's, pacemakers, and ILR's) through in-office device interrogations and remote monitoring, advanced rhythm interpretation, general cardiology and electrophysiology outpatient care, collaboration in device management with heart failure service, coverage of main clinic on La Jolla campus and rotating coverage of satellite clinics at a large volume outpatient cardiology clinic. Also to include collaboration in training of ancillary staff, interns, fellows and junior APC team members as needed; Screening and device programming orders for MRI studies; management of device advisories and recalls; Radiation screening; navigation of remote monitoring websites; attendance of team meetings and device related CME opportunities; collaboration with offsite remote monitoring team.

This will include 6-month training period, as appropriate, after which completion of competency regarding independent device interrogation and programming will be expected. After successful completion of training period, eligible for equal share bonus.
